DANIEL CHAPTER 2

Dan 2:31 - Dan 2:45 (NASB)

³¹"You, O king, were looking and behold, there was a single great statue; that statue, which was large and of extraordinary splendor, was standing in front of you, and its appearance was awesome. ³²"The head of that statue was made of fine gold, (BOX 16)

its breast and its arms of silver, (BOX 17)

its belly and its thighs of bronze, (BOX 18)

³³its legs of iron, its feet partly of iron and partly of clay. (BOX 19)

³⁴"You continued looking until a stone was cut out without hands, and it struck the statue on its feet of iron and clay and crushed them. ³⁵"Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver and the gold were crushed all at the same time and became like chaff from the summer threshing floors; and the wind carried them away so that not a trace of them was found. But the stone that struck the statue became a great mountain and filled the whole earth. (BOX 21)

³⁶"This was the dream; now we will tell its interpretation before the king.

³⁷"You, O king, are the king of kings, (BOX 39)

to whom the God of heaven has given the kingdom, the power, the strength and the glory; ³⁸and wherever the sons of men dwell, or the beasts of the field, or the birds of the sky, He has given them into your hand (BOX 2)

and has caused you to rule over them all. You are the head of gold. (BOX 37)

³⁹"After you there will arise another kingdom inferior to you, (BOX 38)

then another third kingdom of bronze, which will rule over all the earth. (BOX 39)

⁴⁰"Then there will be a fourth kingdom as strong as iron; inasmuch as iron crushes and shatters all things, so, like iron that breaks in pieces, it will crush and break all these in pieces. ⁴¹"In that you saw the feet and toes, partly of potter's clay and partly of iron, it will be a divided kingdom; but it will have in it the toughness of iron, inasmuch as you saw the iron mixed with common clay. ⁴²"As the toes of the feet were partly of iron and partly of pottery, so some of the kingdom will be strong and part of it will be brittle. ⁴³"And in that you saw the iron mixed with common clay, they will combine with one another in the seed of men; but they will not adhere to one another, even as iron does not combine with pottery. (BOX 40 and 19)

⁴⁴"In the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which will never be destroyed, and that kingdom will not be left for another people; (BOX 7)

it will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, but it will itself endure forever. (BOX 42)

⁴⁵"Inasmuch as you saw that a stone was cut out of the mountain without hands and that it crushed the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver and the gold, the great God has made known to the king what will take place in the future; so the dream is true and its interpretation is trustworthy." (BOX 21)
