

## THE ANTICHRIST IN DANIEL

<b>SYNOPSIS</b>	<b>PARALLEL PASSAGES</b>	<b>PASSAGES IN CH 11 &amp; 12</b>
1. The fourth kingdom eventually becomes a federated world government	Dan 2:41-43 "divided kingdom...some of the kingdom will be strong and part of it will be brittle...they will combine with one another...but they will not adhere to one another" Dan 7:23 – “will devour the whole earth”	
2. The world is divided into ten ‘kingdoms’	Dan 2 – ten toes Dan 7 – ten horns ('kings')	
3. AC rises to power during the time of the ten kings	Dan 7:8 “another horn, a little one, came up among them”	Dan 11:21 “In his place” – that is, in the place of the previous King of the North (Syria – one of the four divisions of the Greek Empire)
4. AC comes from one of the four divisions of the Greek Empire, specifically, Syria	Dan 8:9 “Out of one of [the four horns of the Greek Empire] came forth a rather small horn” Dan 8:23 “In the latter period of [the rule of the four horns of the Greek Empire] when the transgressors have run their course, a king will arise”	Dan 11:21 “on whom the honor of kingship has not been conferred”
5. AC starts out small and doesn't look like a king at first	Dan 7:8 “another horn, a little one” Dan 8:9 “a rather small horn” Dan 7:24 “he will be different from the previous [kings]”	Dan 11:21 “he will come in a time of tranquility”
6. AC rises to power in time of peace	I Thess 5:1-3 “the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. While they are saying 'Peace and safety!' then destruction will come upon them suddenly” Dan 8:25 “he will destroy many while they are at ease”	Dan 11:21 “[he will] seize the kingdom by intrigue
7. AC seizes power by intrigue rather than by force at first, but his power will quickly become overwhelming	Dan 8:23 “[he will be] skilled in intrigue Dan 8:24 “His power will be mighty, but not by his own power” Dan 8:25 “through his shrewdness he will cause deceit to succeed by his influence” Dan 7:8 “three of the first horns were pulled out by the roots before it” Dan 9:26 “The people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. And its end will come with a flood; even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined.” Dan 8:10 “It grew up to the host of heaven and caused some of the host and some of the stars to fall to the earth, and it trampled them down.”	Dan 11:22 “and with the [mighty, power,strength] of a [deluge], they shall be completely [conquered, washed away] before him and shall be [crushed]; yea, also the [leader,ruler] of the [confederacy, league, covenant]”

AC makes a covenant for 7 years and tranquility will continue for the first 3 ½ years as he expands his power base southward and eastward	Dan 9:27 "And he will make a firm covenant with the many for one week" Dan 8:9 "[he] grew exceedingly great toward the south, toward the east, and toward the Beautiful Land."	Dan 11:23 "After an alliance is made with him he will practice deception, and he will go up and gain power with a small force of people." 9. Isa 19:4 "I will hand the Egyptians over to the power of a cruel master, and a fierce king will rule over them" Dan 8:24 "he will destroy to an extraordinary degree...he will destroy mighty men and the holy people" Dan 8:12 "the host will be given over to the horn along with the regular sacrifice, and it will fling truth to the ground and perform its will and prosper"	Dan 11:25 "He will stir up his strength...against the king of the South [who] ...will not stand" Dan 11:28 "Then [the AC] will return to his land with much plunder; but his heart will be set against the holy covenant" Dan 11:30 "he will...become enraged at the holy covenant and take action...and show regard for those who forsake the holy covenant"
10. AC stops the daily sacrifices to God and desecrates the Temple, setting up "the abomination that causes desolation"	Dan 8:11 "It removed the regular sacrifice from Him, and the place of His sanctuary was torn down. Dan 9:27 "...and on the wing of abominations will come one who makes desolate" Matt 24:15 "So when you see standing in the holy place 'the abomination that causes desolation' spoken of through the prophet Daniel...let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains"	Dan 11:31 "Forces from him will arise, desecrate the sanctuary fortress, and do away with the regular sacrifice. And they will set up the abomination of desolation"
11. AC sets himself up as God, but he will be opposed by the true believers, many of whom will be martyred	Dan 8:11 "It even magnified itself to be equal with the Commander of the host" Dan 8:25 "...he will magnify himself in his heart...he will even oppose the Prince of princes" Dan 7:8 "this horn possessed eyes like the eyes of a man and a mouth uttering great boasts"	Dan 11:32-33 "By smooth words he will turn to godlessness those who act wickedly toward the covenant, but the people who know their God will display strength and take action. Those who have insight among the people will give understanding to the many; yet they will fall by sword and by flame, by captivity and by plunder for
